4. दिल्ली में राशन डीलर्स के लाइसेंस के नवीनीकरण हेतु लाइसेंसी की अधिकतम उम 60 वर्ष से पाबंदी हटाए सरकार.
5. दिल्ली में सभी राशन दुकानों के लाइसेंस के नवीनीकरण भविष्य में ऑनलाइन करे सरकार.
6. दिल्ली में राशन वितरण के उपरान्त होने वाली छिद्दत (HANDLING LOSS) को पहले की भांति स्वीकृति दे सरकार
7. दिल्ली में राशन की दूकान पर राशन उतरवाई (UNLOADING) के बाद ,लेबर द्वारा अनावश्यक चार्ज 10 रुपये प्रति क्विंटल की सख्ती से बढ़ करे सरकार.

- (13) The State Government shall take such necessary checks to ensure that all quantity and the same quality of foodgrains as allotted to them reaches their godown and is sent at the fair price shop.
14. **Distribution of foodgrains by States.—**(1) The allocation of foodgrains made by the Central Government under the Targeted Public Distribution System to the State Government shall be used for distribution as per the provisions of the Food Security Act and not for any other purpose.
- (2) The State Government shall furnish a distribution certificate every year in the format as at Annex-III.
- (3) The State Government shall ensure, through the authorised agency, physical delivery of foodgrains to the fair price shop by the end of the month preceding the date of receipt of allotment and in any case not later than 15 days of the allocation through—
- (a) the State Government, (b) District Collector, (c) District Magistrate or District Revenue Officer, (d) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (e) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (f) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (g) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (h) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (i) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (j) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (k) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (l) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (m) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (n) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (o) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (p) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (q) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (r) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (s) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (t) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (u) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (v) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (w) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (x) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (y) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies, (z) District Milk Producers' Cooperative Societies.
15. **Regulating and regulation of fair price shops.—**(1) The State Government shall issue an order under section 3 of the Act, or not inconsistent with this Order, for regulating the sale and distribution of the essential commodities.
- (2) The licences to the fair price shop owners shall be issued under the said order and the order issued by the State Government shall be not readily displayed on web portal.
- (3) The designated authority appointed by the State Government shall issue the licences to the fair price shop owners.
- (4) The State Government shall ensure preference to public institutions or public bodies such as handicaps, differently abled, women, etc. in the opening of fair price shops and management of fair price shops by women or their collectives.
- (5) The licences to the fair price shop owners shall be issued keeping in view the viability of the fair price shop.
- (6) The State Government shall ensure that the number of ration card holders attached to a fair price shop are reasonable, the fair price shop is so located that the consumer or ration card holder does not have to face difficulty to reach the fair price shop and the proper coverage is ensured in hilly, desert, tribal and such other areas difficult to access.
- (7) The State Government shall fix an amount as the fair price shop owner's margin, which shall be periodically reviewed for ensuring sustained viability of the fair price shop operations.
- (8) The State Government shall put in place a mechanism to ensure the release of fair price shop owner's margin within a year.
16. **Other provisions.—**(1) The State Government shall take such measures to ensure the viability of the fair price shop operations.
- (2) The State Government shall take such measures to ensure the viability of the fair price shop operations.
17. **Operation of fair price shops.—**(1) The fair price shop owner shall submit a declaration of the stock of foodgrains as per his entitlement under the Targeted Public Distribution System.
- (2) The ration card holder may draw his full entitlement of foodgrains in more than one instalment.
- (3) The fair price shop owner shall not return the ration cards after the supply of the foodgrains.
- (4) The licence issued by the State Government to the fair price shop owner shall lay down the duties and responsibilities of the fair price shop owner which shall include, inter alia,—
- (a) issue of foodgrains as per the entitlement of ration card holder under the Targeted Public Distribution System in the advanced retail shops,
- (b) display of information on a notice board at a prominent place in the shop on daily basis regarding (i) entitlement of foodgrains, (ii) scale of issue, (iii) retail issue prices, (iv) timings of opening and closing of the fair price shop including lunch break, if any, (v) stock of foodgrains received during the month, (vi) opening and closing stock of foodgrains, (vii) the mechanism including authority for redressal of grievances with respect to quality and quantity of foodgrains under the Targeted Public Distribution System and (viii) toll-free helpline number,
- (c) maintenance of the records of ration card holders, e.g. stock register, sale or sale register shall be in the form prescribed by the State Government including in the electronic form in progress wherever,
- (d) display of samples of foodgrains being supplied through the fair price shop.

ORDER

The Lt. Governor, Delhi is pleased to revise the margin money of Fair Price Shop Dealers on the Specified Food Articles (SFAs) i.e. wheat and rice from the existing Rs.35/- per quintal to Rs.70/- per quintal.

The Government of India has enacted the National Food Security Act, 2013. The same has been implemented in the NCT of Delhi. Under the provisions of NFSA, 2013 there are two categories of ration card holders i.e. AAY Households and Priority Households. They are getting SFAs at highly subsidized rates i.e. wheat @ Rs.2/- per kg. and rice @ Rs.3/- per kg. The expenditure incurred on the payment of margin money for the SFAs issued to AAY and Priority Households (which includes the old BPL, JRC and ECPC ration card holders) will be borne by the Food Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi under MH-3456-D.113(1) - Streamlining of Public Distribution System with focus upon below poverty line. The revised rate of margin money payable to the FPS Dealers for these categories of households in NCT will be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2014.

Consequent upon revision of margin money, the retail price of Above Poverty Line (Stamped) (APL-S) category for wheat are revised from the existing Rs.7.05 per kg. to Rs.7.40 per kg. and for rice from the existing Rs.9.25 per kg. to Rs.9.60 per kg. to the consumers. The revised rates for this category will be effective from 01/12/14.

This issues with the concurrence of Finance (Expenditure-II) Department, Government of NCT of Delhi vide their CD No.000251475 dated 4.8.2014.

**9. Effective date of Central assistance.**—The Central assistance to the State Government shall be effective from the date of allocation of foodgrains under the Act and shall be only for allocations made for entitled persons and households.

**10. Release of Central assistance.**—(1) In the first year of the implementation of the Act, seventy five per cent. of the total Central share of expenditure, calculated on the basis of estimated annual allocation of food grains for the entitled persons and households, the norms of expenditure and Central share as mentioned in sub-rule (1) of rule 7 shall be released to the State Government in advance as first instalment, at the beginning of financial year.

(2) The balance twenty five per cent. of the Central assistance shall be released in the following financial year.

(3) The admissibility of total annual Central assistance and its amount shall be calculated out on the basis of,-

- (a) the quantity of food grains actually distributed during the financial year under the Act;
- (b) actual per quintal rates at which the expenditure was incurred by the State Government or Union territory on intra-State movement and handling of food grains and margins paid to fair price shop dealers, or the norms of expenditure specified in sub-rule (1) of rule (7), whichever is lower; and
- (c) norms of Central share specified in sub-rule (1) of rule 7.

(4) After release of first instalment, if any amount is due, it shall be released as the second instalment.

(5) In case of release of excess amount in the first instalment, the same shall be adjusted against due Central assistance for the subsequent financial year.

(6) For release of second instalment, the State Government shall furnish information in the proformas prescribed at Schedule I and Schedule II to these rules.

(7) In subsequent years, Central assistance shall be calculated on the basis of;

- (a) estimated annual allocation of food grains for the entitled persons and households to the State;
- (b) the actual per quintal rates at which expenditure was incurred by the State Government or Union territory during the previous year on intra-State transportation and handling of food grains and margin paid to the fair shop dealers separately or the norms of expenditure mentioned in sub-rule (1) of rule 7 whichever is lower; and
- (c) norms of Central share specified in sub-rule (1) of rule 7.

(8) Seventy five per cent. of the Central assistance estimated under sub-rule (7), shall be released as first instalment in the beginning of the financial year.

(9) The balance twenty five per cent. Central assistance shall be released as second instalment in the next financial year subject to the conditions specified in sub-rules (3) (4) (5) and (6).

**11. Release of Central assistance for previous years.**—In States and Union territories where implementation of the Act had started in the year(s) before coming into force of these rules, release of due Central assistance for previous years shall be made on the basis of information to be furnished by the States or Union territories, as the case may be, in the proformas prescribed at Schedule I and Schedule II to these rules.

**12. Utilisation certificate.**—The State Government and Union territory shall submit utilisation certificate in prescribed proforma to the Central Government, as provided under General Financial Rules, 2005.
